

## THERAPEUTIC GOODS ACT

Few pieces of legislation have had such profound effects on the natural health field as the TGA. In keeping with some its many provisions, anyone wishing to offer PhytoDynamic Therapy as part of their practise needs to be a member of a relevant professional body mentioned in Schedule 1 of the Therapeutic Goods Act.

For example, Practitioner Only Medicines are available to any natural health practitioner who complies with the regulations. The DynaPharm concentrates are available ONLY to financial members of a schedule 1 Association.

Further than this, the DynaPharm **concentrates** have been clearly marked NOT TO BE TAKEN. This labelling emphasises the fact that the bottles of DynaPharm are NOT therapeutic substances as supplied to practitioners. The bottles contain only herbal extracts which are not therapeutically active as supplied. They need to be turned into medicines or ointments before they can be used in clinic.

To manifest the extraordinary healing properties of DynaPharm, each bottle of concentrate must be personally diluted and potentised in the practitioner's clinic. Not only does this incorporate the practitioner's individual energies and healing skills into the blends, it constitutes the action of preparing therapeutic goods under the Act. And it is quite acceptable under the law for each registered practitioner to prepare blends for their own use with their own patients.

Despite the TGA, we still practise under Common Law and remain personally liable to the Federal Government for our actions in a professional capacity. It is legal to make, dispense and prescribe your own blends in all six states, but - most importantly - DynaPharm blends must NOT be on display for sale to the public, off the shelf or over the counter. It is a vital condition of membership that ALL prescriptions are prepared and dispensed for each client or patient at the time of their consultation.

DynaPharm blends are available ONLY to practitioners for their own clinical use. In compliance with the various Statutes and Regulations, no specific claims are made for the application or use of DynaPharm preparations. The blends are not medicines or therapeutic goods, but are Dietary Supplements designed for use as part of a comprehensive care program. Classical and traditional indications from herbal or homoeopathic literature are supplied for academic interest only.
